


ENGINEERING AND CIP PROJECTS

◆ Renovations at the Hindu Temple in Placentia

The Radha Raman Vedic Mandir located at 1022 N. Bradford Avenue is currently in the process of demolishing the current and adjacent buildings. Members of the Hindu Temple will be constructing two new state of the art, eco-friendly buildings on the 1.1 acre site. Grading plans were reviewed and approved by the Engineering Division. Architectural and structural plans are being reviewed by the Planning and Building Divisions. The photo is a small scale replica of the future Hindu Temple in Placentia.



POLICE DEPARTMENT

◆ Significant Events

February 19, 2015

Numerous 911 calls were received in reference to multiple suspects attacking several males and a female with shovels in the 900 block of Lawrence. Upon arrival, a vehicle was located in the street with three injured victims. One adult male suffered severe injuries to his head and was transported to a local trauma center. The other occupants were treated at the scene. Investigations responded and took over the investigation.

February 20, 2015

Traffic conducted a DUI checkpoint on the 600 block of W. Chapman and made 6 arrests. One arrest was for a warrant, another for possession of methamphetamines and oxycodone, and 4 for being in a stolen vehicle. The vehicle was an unreported stolen and was discovered as a result of the investigation in the secondary inspection area. A Police Officer made an arrest for possession of meth and another Police Officer arrested a male for being under the influence of a controlled substance, both off of bike stops.

A Police Officer stopped a male adult on a bike for a VC violation on Yorba Linda west of Bradford. After handing the Police Officer his driver's license, the male fled on foot. Police Officers chased the male on foot for about 2 blocks but lost sight of him in an apartment complex. The male had a warrant for his arrest for resisting arrest and dropped methamphetamines at the scene of the bike stop.

Development Services Project List

Building permits were issued for the new ten (10) unit apartment project located at 738 W. La Jolla Street. Developer is building two 5-unit apartments side by side and each unit consists of 1,200 sq. ft. living space with parking underneath the building. Grading permit was issued and grading operation will proceed soon. Cost of the construction is \$1,800,000.00

Solar panel installation plans and structural calculations were reviewed and approved by Building Division on 2/17/15. Total twelve building permits were issued for single family dwellings.

AT & T cell phone modification plans located at 701 Fee Ana Street were reviewed and approved by Planning and Building Divisions on 2/18/15. Scope of work involves adding more antennas and related equipment to the existing 54'-0" mono-pine structure.
