3 HOUR PARKING LIMITS

FROM 7AM – 5 PM, MONDAY-FRIDAY

NANCITA CIRCLE

TSC NO.: 15 - 05

MEETING DATE: MAY 18, 2015

REQUEST:

A request for the establishment of 3 hour parking limits from 7 a.m. - 5 p.m., Monday – Friday was received for Nancita Circle.

DISCUSSION:

Nancita Circle is located east of Fee Ana Street in the southeast area of the City (see Exhibit 1). Nancita Circle is approximately 600 feet long ending east of Fee Ana Street in a cul-de-sac. It is an industrial street with nine industrial/commercial buildings.

The request is being made in response to a lack of on-street parking in front of these businesses by vehicles parked all day long by workers outside of the area, not working at the businesses on Nancita Circle.

The petition was received, signed by 89% (8 out of 9) property owners/business owners requesting the limited parking restrictions (see Exhibit 2).

A parking utilization study was conducted for several days beginning Friday, May 8, 2015, and ending Tuesday, May 12, 2015. The following show the percentages of on-street parking that was occupied for each of the four days:

- Friday, May 8, 2015, 10a.m. 98 Percent Occupied
2:30p.m. 95 Percent Occupied
- Sunday, May 10, 2015, 1:30p.m. 12 Percent Occupied
- Monday, May 11, 2015, 7:30a.m. 84 Percent Occupied
- Tuesday, May 12, 2015, 7:45a.m. 98 Percent Occupied

RECOMMENDATION:

Based on the fact that almost 90 percent of the property/business owners signed a petition and that for three week days an average of 94 percent of the street was occupied by non-business workers, staff recommends the Traffic Safety Commission approve a 3 hour parking limit restriction from 7 a.m. – 5 p.m., Monday – Friday on Nancita Circle.

SUBJECT: 3-HOUR TIME LIMIT PARKING RESTRICTION-NANCITA CIRCLE

This notice is to invite you to attend the Placentia Traffic Safety Commission meeting on May 18, 2015. The Commission will consider a recommendation to establish a 3 hour time limit parking zone from 7am-5pm, Monday-Friday on Nancita Circle. The City's guidelines require notification of businesses within 300 feet of the requested zone.

The Traffic Safety Commission will consider this item in response to a petition supported by the majority of the business owners on Nancita Circle. The requested 3 hour time limit parking zone would address business concerns about vehicles parking on the street from other areas. The Commission will receive input and make a recommendation to the City Council as to whether the 3 hour time limit parking zone should be established. The City Council will make the final decision at a subsequent meeting.

The meeting will be held in the Community Meeting Room at the Placentia Civic Center, 401 East Chapman Avenue at 7:00 p.m. If you cannot attend but wish to submit comments, please mail or email them to Catherine Carranza (ccarranza@placentia.org) to arrive prior to the close of business on May 18, 2015 at 6:00 pm.
