## **City Actions Taken in Response to Alleged Misappropriation of Public Funds**

At the April 19, 2016 Placentia City Council meeting an update was provided to residents on the alleged actions a City employee took to manipulate the City’s financial system for personal gain.

Michael Minh Nguyen, Finance Services Manager for the City of Placentia was arrested on April 13 for embezzlement of more than \$4 million of public funds. \$1.5 million has been recovered. The City is cooperating with the Orange County District Attorney’s Office, the FBI and other federal agencies to recover additional funds. An existing \$1 million insurance policy may result in the City recovering additional funds. It appears Nguyen allegedly created a sophisticated financial system to conceal his actions from multiple financial experts.

The City took swift and deliberate actions upon learning of Nguyen’s alleged misconduct:

- The City immediately locked Nguyen out of all financial and electronic controls, and he was suspended.
- The same day, the City contacted the DA’s Office to conduct an independent investigation.
- The City cooperated with the DA in gathering evidence of misconduct.
- The DA arrested Nguyen within 24 hours.
- The City’s internal financial controls were immediately strengthened to provide additional security.

“To get to the root of this issue and ensure it never occurs again I’ve requested a full independent investigation to determine if there is any other involvement by City personnel,” said Placentia Mayor Jeremy Yamaguchi in his opening comments at the City Council meeting. “I also believe it is important for the City to hire an independent Forensic Auditor to conduct an independent review of our financial system.”

At the meeting the City Council voted unanimously to retain a Forensic Auditor to provide an independent investigation and establish enhanced financial systems, procedures and controls.

Mayor Yamaguchi added: “It goes without saying that the Council and I are extremely disappointed with the breach of public trust that has occurred. For some time now, the City Council has been working hard to rebuild trust and move the City forward. Now more than ever, we must stand united as one Council to ensure Placentia continues to move forward.”

## Veterans Advisory Committee Programs and Services

The Placentia Veterans Advisory Committee consists of an eleven (11) member Committee appointed by the City Council. The Committee serves as an advisory group to the City Council and has successfully established several community programs. These programs include the annual Veterans Day Observance Ceremony, the Burial Flag Program, and the Flag Day Ceremony. The Committee was also essential in the establishment of the Veterans Monument in 1994 to honor residents who have served or are currently serving in the armed forces.

# Aquatics

## Learn to Swim Program

The City of Placentia Learn-To-Swim Program offers swimming instruction for youth ages nine months through twelve years. All Water Safety Instructors are trained and certified by the American Red Cross. The program is offered at Valencia High School in the morning and afternoon and at El Dorado High School for evening classes.

## Registration Information

Learn-To-Swim Program registration begins at the Summer Recreation Program Kick-off event on **Saturday, May 21** at Placentia City Hall and is **not available online**. Only Placentia residents will be permitted to register on this day. A parent or legal guardian must be present to register a child. Proof of residency (ie driver's license, State issued ID card, or recent utility bill) must be provided to be eligible to register. Registration numbers will be handed out on a first-come, first-serve basis beginning at 7:00 AM. Registration will begin at 9:00 AM and continues until 12:00 PM. Proof of age is required at the time of registration for new program participants (Birth Certificate).



### Big Fish, Lil Fish

#### 9 months to 3 years

A basic water orientation class for tots and their parents. The child and parent work on skills together in the water such as: water adjustment, blowing bubbles, kicking, holding onto the wall, floating on back, water entry and exit, face submergence, and safety skills. A parent is required to accompany each child.

### Tiny Tots

#### 3 to 5 years

A class for preschoolers who have very little to no aquatic experience. Fun and safety are emphasized while learning necessary swimming skills: water entry and exit, face submergence, blowing bubbles, water adjustment, kicking, exploring arm movements and safety skills.



### Level 1

#### 5 to 12 years

A class for children who have very little to no aquatic experience. Fun and safety are emphasized while learning necessary swimming skills; water entry and exit, bobbing, face submergence, water adjustment, floating on front and back, retrieval of submerged objects and safety skills. In this class children will learn how to side breathe as well as practice freestyle and backstroke.

### Level 2

#### 5 to 12 years

Class reviews entry by stepping or jumping from side, bobbing, head submergence and holding breath, floating on front and back, treading water, side breathing, freestyle, backstroke, and safety skills. Participants will also be introduced to elementary backstroke.

**Prerequisite:** Participant must be able to demonstrate the following with little to no assistance; safely enter and exit the water, float on front and back without support, swim the entire length of the pool freestyle.



### Level 3

#### 5 to 12 years

In this class children will review side breathing techniques, freestyle, backstroke, and elementary backstroke. They will also be introduced to breaststroke and kneeling and standing dives. Participants will continue to practice treading water, retrieving submerged objects, and safety skills.

**Prerequisite:** Participants should be very comfortable in the water and able to swim at least one lap (25 yards) without any assistance.



### Level 4

#### 5 to 12 years

Class will continue to practice treading water, retrieving submerged objects, kneeling and standing dives, and safety skills. Along with perfecting freestyle, backstroke, and breaststroke, they will be introduced to butterfly.

**Prerequisite:** Participants should be very confident freestyle swimmers and comfortable with backstroke and breaststroke.

### Level 5

#### 5 to 12 years

The course will focus on reviewing all of the strokes, underwater swimming, dives, flip turns, and safety skills including survival swimming and rescue breathing.

**Prerequisite:** Swimmers should be comfortable with all swimming strokes and able to swim constantly throughout the 30 minute class.



### Public Recreation Swim

The City of Placentia offers free recreation swim at the Gomez Community Pool and at the Whitten Community Pool. Children seven years and under must be accompanied by an adult in a swimsuit and must be within arm's reach at all times. Floatation devices are NOT allowed during recreation swim.




