**ORAL COMMUNICATIONS** – This is the time for members of the public to address the committee.

**1. Approval of Minutes**

The minutes from last meeting were approved, but needed one correction on a last name. Ron White motioned to approve the minutes, and then was followed by a second motion by Dixie Shaw.

**2. Senior Center Operations**

Committee discussed the Volunteer Recognition Breakfast. They discussed the name tags they received. The Committee was very pleased with their new name tags and with the Volunteer breakfast. Beverly inquired about the patio furniture and Jon Nicks explained that a recycling grant was used to purchase the patio furniture and will be delivered soon. Jon Nicks discussed bringing in computers into to the Senior Center. Jon also talked about the sign that is in front of the Senior Center and how costly it is. Ron White suggested possibly having the Rotary Club donate money towards the sign. The Committee discussed the need for BINGO prizes. They would like to use money in the fund to buy better prizes, and they need for yarn. They also discussed having someone come in to talk about children in need and donate to children with Cleft Palates. The Committee would like a report on the funds in the account of the Senior Center. The Committee discussed having a standalone air conditioner placed in the Senior Center Kitchen. Jon Nicks explained that the air conditioner will be sent over to the Senior Center very soon.

**5. Excursions:**

Committee discussed the Christmas show on December 9 at 2:00. It is \$22 a ticket and The Rotary Club has 50 tickets available. They discussed The Rotary fundraiser, Cowabunga. The Rotary made over \$20,000 at the event that will be going towards student scholarships. They discussed concerts in the park. No one from Emerald Isle wants to go to it because they play BINGO Thursday nights. Jon brought up the Free Senior day at the Aquarium of the Pacific. It is held on September 6<sup>th</sup> at 9:00 AM in Long Beach.

**6. COMMITTEE COMMENTS AND REPORTS**

One committee member wanted to bring up Fullerton senior transportation. They give out booklets for \$29.00 and have free transportation for their seniors. There was discussion about attending the Relay for Life event in August and raising the \$100.00 team fee to participate. Beverly Cardwell would like a booth at the Heritage Festival. They would like to sell knitted hats and have a canopy, three tables, and four chairs. Dixie mentioned information about City of Fullerton coupon booklets for Senior Center transportation. The booklets have tickets to theaters and discounts to various stores and restaurants.
