PUBLIC COMMENTS:

Cindy Pena of 201 Dartmouth Way expressed concern with inconsistency of enforcing parking in her neighborhood.

Mr. Miller introduced Rusty Beardsley Traffic Engineer to the Commission.

PUBLIC HEARING:

TSC NO. 15-07

Consideration of Resident-Only Permit Parking Zone on Stanford Drive, Mission Way to Central Avenue be effective 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

Mr. Miller stated that the Permit Parking Zone excludes Stanford Circle and the North side of Stanford Drive in front of the school. Mr. Miller presented his report and offered to answer any questions from the Commission.

Chairperson Hernandez asked if City Council approved the new requirements and fees for Permit Parking. Mr. Miller stated that the new requirements and fees will be presented to Council once the Public Works Manager position is filled.

Chairperson Hernandez opened the Public Hearing.

Warren Emens 718 Stanford Drive expressed concern with nonresidents parking on Stanford Drive.

Ryan Velasquez 736 Stanford Drive expressed concern with the safety of kids being dropped off at John Tynes School due to residents of Cinnamon Tree taking up parking on the North side of Stanford in front of the school.

Chairperson Hernandez closed the public hearing at 7:34 p.m.

Commissioner Ruppert commented on treating the parking issues in the City. He also suggested reviewing the fees to cover the cost of the parking program.

Commissioner Sarmiento asked if there is any documentation of accidents in the Stanford Drive area due to the current parking issues. Mr. Miller stated that he has not done a search on this information.

MOTION BY COMMISSIONER STAFFORD TO ACCEPT STAFF RECOMMENDATION AS WRITTEN, SECOND BY COMMISSIONER GORMAN AND CARRIED BY A 5-1 VOTE. (RUPPERT OPPOSED)
