The Norton Simon Museum in Pasadena is known around the world as one of the most remarkable private art collections ever assembled. Over a thirty-year period industrialist Norton Simon (1907–1993) amassed an astonishing collection of European art from the Renaissance to the 20th century and a stellar collection of South and Southeast Asian art spanning 2,000 years. Approximately 1,000 works from the permanent collection of 12,000 objects are on view in the Norton Simon Museum's galleries and sculpture garden throughout the year.


## A TRANSFORMING OPPORTUNITY COMES TO PLACENTIA'S PACKING HOUSE DISTRICT

The City of Placentia has been given a unique opportunity with the new state-of-the-art Metrolink Station and 253-space parking structure within the Old Town Placentia area. Operational by 2020, the proposed Station can help transform the Packing House District (near Melrose Street and Crowther Avenue) into an active, vibrant destination. Transit-oriented development, or TOD, is a type of community development that includes a mixture of housing, retail, services, and other amenities integrated into a walkable neighborhood and located within a half-mile of a major public transportation stop such as the proposed Metrolink Station. To facilitate this transformation, the City of Placentia has approved an amendment to the General Plan and Zoning Code with specific standards to allow a mixed use, pedestrian oriented retail and residential district, creating new development opportunities for a one-of-a-kind destination. It will also support existing retail and restaurant businesses in the nearby Old Town District and will benefit the citywide and regional economy.



The future TOD District will generate public and private investments of up to \$495 million in the District and the City. Upon completion, the TOD project area (pictured) is estimated to generate approximately \$1,550,000 in General Fund revenue for the City. Additionally, the proposed TOD District area would assist with reconstructing streets and providing enhanced street improvements. 
