CITYWIDE MEDIAN RENOVATION PROJECT

As a result of mandatory water restrictions imposed by the State in 2014, Cities are barred from watering turf grass medians. In response, the City began planning for renovations of its turf grass medians and in Fiscal Year (FY) 2017-18 completed renovations of landscaped medians along Kraemer Boulevard between Chapman Avenue and Alta Vista Street; and Rose Drive between Alta Vista and Buena Vista Streets. As part of the Capital Improvement Program Budget for FY 2018-19, the City Council allocated funding towards the Citywide Median Turf Renovation Project to renovate existing turf grass medians on Rose Drive between Alta Vista and Buena Vista Streets; and Kraemer Boulevard between Alta Vista Street and Bastanchury Road.



In addition, the City partnered with the Metropolitan Water District of Orange County (MWDOC), Yorba Linda Water District (YWLD) & Golden State Water Company (Golden State Water) to secure a total of \$85,733 in rebate funds through MWDOC's Turf Removal Program to help offset project costs. The program's main goal is to reduce outdoor watering by transforming water-thirsty turfgrass to a California native and/or Friendly landscape that benefits the watershed by reducing runoff and utilizing natural resources, such as rainwater. The program is designed to incentivize residents and commercial customers to remove water intensive turf grass, which uses more water than any other plant in the urban landscape and replace it with a water wise landscape.

In January 2019, the Public Works Maintenance crew completed the renovations on these medians. Staff anticipates saving approximately 5 million gallons of water each year as a result of these improvements.

The City would like to thank the staff at MWDOC, YWLD & GSWC for assisting us in securing the additional funds for this project. These funds allowed us to expand the project boundaries. All of their valuable time and efforts spent providing information and helping Staff meet rebate deadlines is greatly appreciated.

THE PLACENTIA POLICE DEPARTMENT'S APPROACH TO WHOLE COMMUNITY DISASTER PREPAREDNESS

Throughout the State of California, many people have seen the catastrophic levels of devastation that often occurs from large-scale wildfires, earthquakes, and other human-induced disasters. The immediate response and destruction that typically occurs from these events initially overwhelms the local and county first responders, but the shining light that is found in these incidents is from the large number of volunteers that arrive to help their fellow neighbors and first responders.

When large-scale emergencies occur throughout the nation, we often find that the untraditional first responders are neighbors helping neighbors; therefore, it is the mission of the Placentia Police Department's Emergency Services Division to provide consistent training and resources to the members of our community to ensure that in an emergency, our neighborhoods and communities can quickly recover from a disaster. In Emergency Management, many officials term this act of kindness and self-sustainability as the Whole Community Approach to disasters, and in Placentia we believe the Whole Community Approach is critical to our city's resilience!

Overall, the Whole Community Approach to disaster preparedness focuses on the entire community's collective and shared responsibility to prepare for and respond to emergencies and disasters. The shared responsibility can be seen in individuals making family emergency contact plans, storing important information in accessible locations, signing up for local wireless emergency alerts (Nixle and AlertOC), and actively participating in neighborhood disaster preparedness groups, such as CERT (Community Emergency Response Team). Each of these components helps reduce the disaster vulnerability of the City of Placentia, and it helps promote the Whole Community Approach as we develop a culture of community preparedness throughout the City. Maintaining a culture of preparedness is not only important to those who look to volunteer with the City of Placentia or assist their fellow neighbors; but most first responders and emergency managers have clearly recognized the power

of the Whole Community Approach when they respond to areas that have increased levels of community preparedness. To ensure that our residents are ready for a large-scale emergency, the Placentia Police Department's Emergency Services Division is seeking to develop a city-wide group of volunteers that are trained and willing to respond to large-scale emergencies in their neighborhoods, throughout the city, and potentially throughout Orange County. Trained members of CERT and RACES often assist the Placentia Police Department and other components of the City in many ways and each person truly provides an invaluable level of support during large events and emergencies.

To sustain and increase our level of preparedness, a free CERT course is offered to the public three times a year – Winter, Summer and Fall. The courses are free for Placentia residents to take, and 20-hours of training in the areas of Fire Suppression, Terrorism, Search and Rescue, Disaster Medical Operations; and Disaster Psychology are provided throughout the course. Upon completion of the training, each member will be given the option to further their individual training with the City of Placentia's CERT Team, this is a deployable group of volunteers that actively supports the community and the City of Placentia staff, but most importantly, these members serve their individual neighborhoods.

UPDATE ON PLACENTIA'S FIRE PROTECTION AND EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES

Public Safety is our top priority. For the past 23 years, the City of Placentia has contracted with Orange County Fire Authority (OCFA) to provide local fire and emergency medical services to our residents.

As our local population continues to age and the calls for corresponding medical services have increased -- now constituting nearly 80% of calls for service -- and as wildfire hazards have become deadlier, cities have substantially modified the way they prepare for fire hazards, the service model used to deliver Placentia's life-saving fire and emergency medical services must evolve as well. The City seeks to maintain and enhance rapid medical emergency response times and ensure a high level of these life-saving services over the long-term, for our residents.

Since 2009, the City's costs with OCFA has grown by 47%, with no change in service levels being provided to our residents. At the same time, the City's operating budget has only grown by 12%. Also important to note that during this same time period, the Placentia Police Department has experienced a 9% decrease in its operating budget. Placentia has a responsibility to its residents to ensure local fire and paramedic

models are continually improving, high quality, fiscally sustainable, to ensure proper spending priorities on services to our residents.

Towards this end, the City is undertaking a competitive process to solicit proposals from qualified service providers for fire protection services and emergency medical services to ensure the City can maintain AND enhance rapid emergency response programs well into the future, when considering our population and community's needs.

Potential service or cost efficiencies will also enable the City to invest more robustly in proactive law enforcement safety approaches, which our public has said is a priority. The City views public safety in a holistic approach that includes not only fire protection services but also our local Police Department which includes proactive community policing, investigation, gang reduction and intervention efforts and other ways of preventing crime before it happens.

UPDATE ON MEASURE U: ONE-CENT SALES TAX BALLOT MEASURE

After significant community input and upon receiving the Citizens Fiscal Sustainability Task Force’s final report, on July 24, 2018, the Placentia City Council unanimously (5-0) placed Measure U, a local one-cent sales tax measure, on the November 6, 2018 ballot. Based on the final results provided by the Orange County Register of Voters, Measure U was approved by Placentia voters by 63%. The measure is a one-cent sales tax increase that will go into effect on April 1, 2019. The City will receive its first installment of the one-cent sales tax in June/July, 2019. The one-cent sales tax is projected to raise approximately \$5 million annually.

We appreciate the community’s interest in Measure U and thank all of the residents who participated in the election, as well as the efforts over the past two years of the Citizens Fiscal Sustainability Task Force. The success of Measure U means that we will be able to maintain the City’s Police Department and enhance public safety, repair potholes and pave local streets and keep streets and public areas safe and clean. Measure U will allow the City to fund services at levels consistent with the community’s priorities and the public’s desired quality of life and would prevent the need for further significant cuts to vital City services and programs.

In addition, in order to protect taxpayers and ensure fiscal accountability, on June 5, 2018 the Placentia City Council voted unanimously (5-0) to update the City’s Reserve Policy to include guidelines for appropriating new ongoing or one-time unrestricted revenues to be used for specific purposes, as shown in the table below. “New Ongoing Revenues” are defined as a new general tax, an increase in the rate of an

existing general tax (such as Measure U), a new lease of City property or other new, clearly identifiable unrestricted revenue source not previously included in the City’s budget at the time of adoption of this policy, which generates at least \$100,000 per year in revenue and is expected to continue for at least a period of 20 years.

The purpose of these distributions is to ensure that the new reserve areas are addressed on a long-term basis and to ultimately improve the City’s fiscal health. To ensure that the policy is applied consistently by future City administrations and Councils, any modification to this policy requires a supermajority or 4/5ths vote of the City Council.

Lastly, Measure U also established an independent Citizens Oversight Committee. The purpose of the Committee will be to review and report on all Measure U expenditure plans and financial reports. The City began accepting applications from the public inviting them to join the Committee in December, 2018 through January, 2019. The City Council will consider the appointment of the Committee Members at a regularly scheduled City Council meeting. Once the members have been established, the Committee will meet regularly and the meetings will be open to the public.

We thank the community for their participation in this local election. We look forward to keeping the community informed and working with them to address and maintain community priorities in Placentia. 
