

Outdoor Dining

A recent announcement by Governor Newsom confirmed that the statewide stay at home order will shortly be changed to “Stage 2,” thereby allowing increased activities for local businesses to include some retail and restaurants, subject to certain restrictions. In preparation of businesses reopening in Stage 2, the City will temporarily reduce its requirements related to outdoor dining in order to assist restaurants who are trying to accommodate the occupancy reductions for indoor dining. The City will also modify its on-site parking requirements to assist retail locations to provide for safe and efficient merchandise pick-up. The City of Placentia is actively monitoring the situation involving the infectious disease outbreak of COVID-19 (Coronavirus). OC COVID-19 Testing Network

The OC COVID-19 Testing Network, which offers COVID-19 testing to Orange County residents who meet certain criteria continues to expand testing across Orange County. The goal is to create a safety net for any community member who is experiencing COVID-19 symptoms but is unable to receive testing through a health care provider. The County has partnered with an initial set of eight community health centers and will continue to expand their network by three additional sites within the next few days. Additional locations are expected in the weeks to come as they have indicated that their goal is to expand to 13-15 locations.

Neighborhood Services

The Neighborhood Services office will continue to operate during its regular hours of operation. Placentia Senior Center

Due to the recent concerns surrounding COVID-19 (coronavirus) and in line with County, State and Federal guidelines and recommendations, the City of Placentia has temporarily closed the Placentia Senior Center. Although the Placentia Senior Center is closed, participants of the Senior Center Lunch Program may choose to pick-up a box lunch Monday through Friday between the hours of 8:30 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. or new participants living in the City of Placentia may enroll in the Meals on Wheels Program. Additionally, Placentia seniors who do not have transportation to the senior center, may sign up with Senior Center staff to receive home delivered meals. Seniors without internet access are encouraged to call (714) 993-8232 for updates between the hours of 7:30 a.m. – 6:00 p.m. Monday through Thursday and at (714) 986-2333 on Fridays from 8:30 a.m. – 5:30 p.m. Please be advised this program is only intended for senior residents of Placentia age 60 and over.

Street Sweeping Enforcement to Resume June 1, 2020

The citywide street sweeping enforcement has been canceled since the stay at home orders went into effect. With the state's reopening process beginning, the City of Placentia will resume enforcement of street sweeping violations on June 1, 2020. Please have the streets clear of vehicles in each of the street sweeping zones to avoid receiving a parking citation. If residents cannot remember the days/times that the street sweeper comes through your street, please refer to the City's website for a map, or call the Placentia Police Department's Traffic Bureau at (714) 993-8157.

Street Maintenance Underway in Placentia

Construction began this week on the FY 2019-20 Residential Slurry Seal Phase 2 Project. This project will slurry seal more than 2.6 million square feet of residential streets. In addition, approximately 7,000 square feet of damaged asphalt pavement will be removed and replaced. Approximately 9,000 square feet of damaged sidewalk panels will be removed and replaced, along with damaged concrete curb and gutter and replacement of all pavement striping and legends. This project is funded with a combination of Measure U, Measure M and SB 1/RMRA and State Gas Tax revenues. Construction is anticipated to be completed by the end of August. This project is part of a series of street maintenance and rehabilitation projects budgeted by the City Council this fiscal year. The City recently solicited bids for construction for the FY 2019-20 Arterial Roadway Rehabilitation Project and anticipates presenting a construction contract for the project to the City Council in July. This project will repave more than 1 million square feet of pavement on Bastanchury Road, Golden Avenue and Kraemer Boulevard. Please click [here](#) to see the area map for this project.

Metropolitan Water District Project

The Metropolitan Water District (MWD) will be undergoing major water pipeline reconstruction on Brookhaven Avenue this summer. MWD is beginning public outreach related to the Relining project to rehabilitate approximately 2,980 feet of this major regional water pipeline primarily on Brookhaven Avenue (between Bastanchury Road and Yorba Linda Boulevard). Construction activity will limit traffic to one-way only near Swanee Avenue. As presented to the City Council on May 5th, nearby residents will soon receive a letter with details about the project. Pizza Rev Coming Soon!

Pizza Rev will soon be opening in the Village Plaza at 1474 N. Kraemer Blvd., located on the southeast corner of Yorba Linda Boulevard and Kraemer Boulevard. Pizza Rev and its two neighboring stores, Starbucks and Chipotle, are part of the Village Plaza Phase I Remodel, which includes new upgraded building facades with Spanish Contemporary architectural design elements and landscape improvements. There is also an outdoor dining area adjacent to the building which serves Pizza Rev, Starbucks and Chipotle.



Pizza Rev opened its first location in Los Angeles in 2012, and it now has almost 30 stores throughout the US and Mexico. It will offer a craft-your-own pizza option where you can choose from different sauces such as marinara, alfredo, or spicy-sweet-BBQ and add as many fresh pizza toppings as you would like! There is a large selection of toppings that include Italian sausage, crispy bacon, mushrooms, roasted garlic, and more.
