Hopes to encourage investment in Atwood. • Audi location construction is moving forward • Alta Vista Rose 54 residential units are progressing; commercial side is not doing as well • JTI hotel dev't is moving along. • The Herald, 5-story, 215-unit luxury living is moving; traffic issues have been analyzed and some improvement will be needed on Crowther • City is having about 700 dwelling units being added which will help with RHNA numbers (Regional Housing Needs Assessment) • Love Placentia planted some trees in the parks
