On March 4, 2020, pursuant to California Government Code Section 8625, Governor Newsom declared a State of Emergency as a result of the threat of the COVID-19 virus.

On September 17, 2021, Governor Newsom signed AB 361, which went into immediate effect as urgency legislation. AB 361 added subsection (e) to Section 54953 to authorize legislative bodies to conduct remote meetings provided the legislative body makes specified findings. As of September 19, 2021 the COVID-19 pandemic had killed more than 67,612 Californians. Social distancing measures decrease the chance of the spread of COVID-19.

Given the health risks associated with COVID-19, please be advised that while the City Council Chambers are open to the public, some or all of the Placentia City Council Members may attend this meeting via teleconference. Those locations are not listed on the agenda and are not accessible to the public.



Coordinator Zambrano informed the committee he has been made aware of a new county program named 'Planet Bids' which allows all city and county projects to be displayed on one website for contractors to view and select from. The city will redo the RFP and submit it to Planet Bids.

Coordinator Zambrano informed the committee, if the transportation bid is successful then the Meals on Wheels program will end as the transportation service would provide Seniors with transportation to and from the Senior Center where there will be hot food provided.

4. **Senior Center Operations**

Coordinator Zambrano provided an update on the Senior Center operations. The Senior Center building is currently closed, and all operations have been temporarily moved to the Backs community room at Kraemer Park. Coordinator Zambrano stated, that due to an oversight by Second Harvest there won't be a grocery drop off for the week.
