

CALL TO ORDER

Community Services Coordinator Zambrano called the meeting to order at 6:20 P.M.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

ORAL COMMUNICATIONS – None.

1. Minutes

- a. The minutes for July 12, 2023 were **MOTIONED** for approval by Committee Member Jordan and was **SECONDED** by Committee Member Montelongo. Motion carried.

2. Meals on Wheels Update

Community Services Coordinator Zambrano updated the Committee regarding the Meals on Wheels program. He informed the Committee that Meals on Wheels and the Orange County Health Department had conducted a site inspection at the Placentia Senior Center, to which the center passed. Points on the inspection were deducted due to not having a grievance procedure or a labeled sanitizer bottle. Coordinator Zambrano also informed the Committee that the center averages between 40-50 meals served per week to senior center participants.

Committee Member Martinez shared that the center has seen an increase of new participants, specifically an increase in male participants.

3. Transportation

Coordinator Zambrano updated the Committee regarding the Senior Centers Transportation. He informed the committee that the transportation service has seen an increase in usage, beginning at 30 total trips reported in April, 71 trips reported in May, and 147 trips in June. Coordinator Zambrano updated the Committee that the parameters of the senior transportation program have been adjusted. The changes allow seniors ages 60+ to schedule transportation to anywhere in Orange County, Monday-Friday 7:00A.M.-8:00P.M. free of cost. Coordinator Zambrano showed the

Committee a flyer detailing the transportation program information, which would be distributed at the site and other city entities the following day.

4. Senior Groceries Update

Coordinator Zambrano provided an update regarding the Senior Grocery program. He reminded the Committee that the service is available the 1st and 3rd Wednesday of the month. The Senior Grocery program consists of protein, produce, canned goods, dairy, fish, and more. The previous week 60 people came in for the program. Committee Member Martinez expressed concerns about the raffle-like system, where Seniors are called up at random to accept groceries. This will be discussed with the site lead Alejandro Ruiz.

5. Senior Center Programming

Committee Member Tricia Montelongo gave an update regarding the proposed Community/ Senior Center. She shared a flyer with the other members showing what the newly proposed Senior Center could look like. The new two story Senior Center would be located at Tri-City Park and would also serve as a Community Center. Member of the Orange County Board of Supervisors, Doug Chaffee, recently donated \$500,000 towards the project. The proposed building is estimated to be 30,000 sq ft.

Coordinator Zambrano informed the Committee that the Placentia Senior Center plans to resume senior field trips, starting as soon as August 27th for the OC Fair.

Coordinator Zambrano updated the Committee that the Senior Center has continued to celebrate Senior birthdays and major holidays like Mother's and Father's Day, and will soon be having a summer luau. The Orange Central Korean Church will return in September to host arts and crafts.

Coordinator Zambrano informed the Committee that the city is working to receive quotes for a new AC system and new windows for the site.

6. Senior Advisory Vacancy

Coordinator Zambrano opened discussions regarding the vacancy on the Senior Advisory Committee. He updated the group that there is currently two open spots on the Committee. Tricia informed the Committee that Jodie Ward is interested in joining and will be interviewed by City Council soon.
