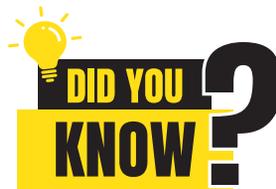

**SOLICITORS AND PEDDLERS**



Solicitors, peddlers, and canvassers must first obtain a permit from the City of Placentia before going door-to-door. According to Placentia Municipal Code (PMC) Section 6.72.010, all City-permitted solicitors, peddlers, and canvassers will be issued an identification card labeled "permit," which must be visibly worn on their outer garment.

Additionally, no peddler or solicitor, whether selling or pretending to sell goods, wares, or merchandise of any kind or taking orders for any article, material, or substance, is allowed to ring the bell or knock on the door of any residence, dwelling, flat, or apartment that has a sign displaying "No Peddlers," "No Solicitors," or "No Peddlers or Solicitors."

If you need to report any suspected unauthorized solicitors, peddlers, or canvassers, please contact Code Enforcement at (714) 993-8165. Stay informed and help keep our community safe!

## UPDATE ON SB 1383 ORGANICS RECYCLING PROGRAM

The City of Placentia, along with every city in the state of California, is required by State law to implement enforcement compliance with both recycling and organic waste recycling programs. California Senate Bill 1383 (SB 1383) requires reductions of organic waste in landfills as part of a greater plan to reduce emissions of short-lived climate pollutants.

Organic waste includes food waste such as vegetables, fruits, cooked meats scraps, dairy, bread, pasta, rice, grains, eggshells, coffee grounds, tea bags, plate scraps, food-soiled paper (i.e., used pizza boxes), and yard waste such as tree trimmings, grass clippings and leaves, and nonhazardous wood waste. SB 1383 establishes targets to achieve a 50% reduction in statewide disposal of organic waste from the 2014 level by 2020 and a 75% reduction by 2025.

The City continues to negotiate with Republic Services on a new Citywide Organics Recycling Program to meet the requirements of SB 1383. The City and Republic Services will provide further information to residents once a program has been approved. Currently, there is no change to the current bins and waste disposal process for Placentia single-family residents.

Hamer Island residents are the exception, since their organics recycling program started in July 2023. Organics recycling services are available to businesses now. ## SAFE EXCHANGE ZONE

As the holidays approach, we would like to remind you that the Placentia Police Department has established a Safe Exchange Zone. We know that Craigslist, Offer Up and other exchange site transactions can sometimes go badly.

To provide the public with a safer environment to do business, the Police Department has designated the front entrance to the police station as a Safe Exchange Zone. The area is well lit, under 24-hour video surveillance, and is clearly marked with signage. This area may be used by the public to conduct child custody exchanges, private property, and E-Commerce transactions, such as Craigslist, Offer Up and others.

This Safe Exchange Zone should help deter potential scammers and other criminal activities associated with on-line purchasing activities, as well as help make child custody exchanges less challenging.

## CHRISTMAS TREE RECYCLING

Every year, more than 40,000 tons of Christmas trees require handling at the end of the season in California. You can help divert waste from the landfill by following these simple steps:

1. Remove the tree stand (wood or metal), decorations and tinsel from your tree.
2. Cut up your tree and place in your brown container (no tree stands please). The pieces should fit easily in your container.
3. Place the brown container at the curb along with the other containers on your regular collection day.

If you are unable to put your tree in your brown yard waste can, place the tree at the curb next to your containers on your regular collection day Thursday, December 26, 2024 until Monday, January 6, 2025. Trees are collected in a special truck.

Trees larger than six-feet must be cut into four-foot lengths. Flocked trees can not be recycled, please call (714) 238-3300 to schedule a pickup. # PLACENTIA'S "EXPAND THE FOREST" PROGRAM



The City of Placentia is still accepting applications for its Expand the Forest Program! This program, adopted as part of the City's Urban Forest Management Program, allows residents to purchase and dedicate a tree to commemorate a loved one or special event. Planting a tree in a City Park is a special way to honor a loved one and provides a gift to the whole community by contributing to the expansion of the City's Urban Forest. A dedication tree can be planted in a City Park, and potential tree sponsors can use a Park map to identify their preferred park and planting location(s).

The cost to purchase and plant a tree will be funded by the tree sponsor and is based on the current contract price paid by the City for 24-inch box trees. The current cost is \$390 for an Expand the Forest tree. Once a location is selected, and payment for the tree has been received, the City will arrange

to have the tree planted by the City's landscape maintenance contractor, with or without the sponsor(s) in attendance, depending on their preference. Once planted, the City will assume maintenance responsibilities to care for the tree. The tree sponsor(s) will receive a certificate signed by the Mayor in appreciation of their tree sponsorship and be acknowledged in the City's quarterly Palm Newsletter.

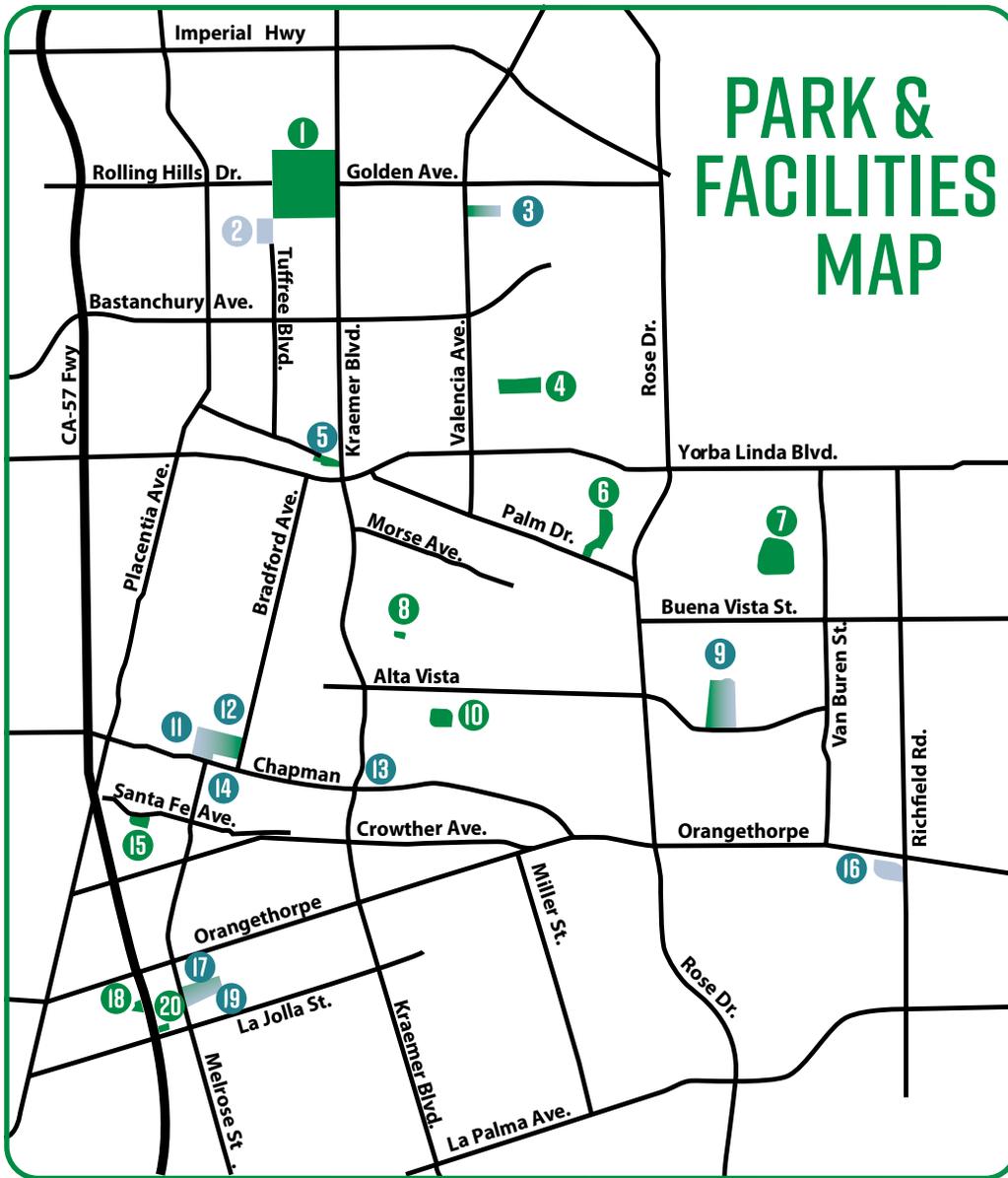

- Budget: \$89,000
