

McFadden Playground Ribbon Cutting Ceremony

The City is excited to announce a **Ribbon Cutting Ceremony** on Thursday, June 26th at 11:30 a.m. at McFadden Park to unveil the newly renovated



playground equipment! In following the Parks Initiative Plan, McFadden Park Playground will now highlight a beach and lifeguard theme with new rubberized surfacing that will incorporate beach elements. Other additions include an incorporated shade, a lighthouse tower, swings, retro surfboard sensory play apparatuses, and new slides. The City extends a sincere thank you to County of Orange Supervisor Doug Chaffee for his generous donation of American Rescue Plan Act funds, which funded the playground renovation. Chick-fil-A Restaurant Nearing Completion

Construction of the new Chick-fil-A restaurant located at the southeast corner of Alta Vista Street and Rose Drive continues to progress steadily. The exterior of the building is now largely complete, with finishing work underway. Construction crews are actively working on architectural details and other exterior enhancements. Significant progress has been made on site infrastructure, and curbs are being poured to define drive aisles and parking spaces, signaling the next phase of development for the site layout. Equipment and utility installation remain ongoing, and crews are preparing the surrounding areas for paving and landscaping.

This Chick-fil-A is part of a larger development approved initially in 2018, which included a neighborhood serving commercial shopping center and a gated residential community. The revised plan consolidates the commercial space into a 5,525-square-foot restaurant with a drive-thru and outdoor dining area, designed to retain much of the site's approved landscaping and hardscape elements.

The City of Placentia is excited to see this project moving closer to completion and anticipates it will be a valuable dining option for the community. For further updates, contact the Development Services Department at (714) 993-8124.

The OC Free Gun Lock Program provides free firearm locks to Orange County residents, helping prevent unauthorized access and reduce the risk of accidents. This program is open to all residents,

with priority given to residents in the Fourth District. Orange County residents can now request free gun locks through an online form at d4.ocgov.com/FreeGunLocks, with locks mailed directly to their homes. Each package includes a QR Code, linking to a video tutorial on safe firearm storage and information about California's evolving gun laws, including SB 53, which requires secure storage for all firearms starting in 2026. Orange County Mosquito and Vector Control District

National Mosquito Awareness Week, which is set for June 15th - 21st this year, typically signals the start of mosquito season. This year is no different. During the first week of June, Orange County Mosquito and Vector Control District (OCMVCD) trapped an astounding 15,488 *Culex erythrothorax* mosquitoes on University of California Irvine marshland and is providing treatments to reduce those numbers. Also known as tule mosquitoes, *Culex erythrothorax* bite at dusk and dawn and can spread West Nile virus, Western equine encephalitis, and St. Louis encephalitis. In addition to the *Culex* genera of mosquitoes, Orange County residents are familiar with invasive *Aedes aegypti* mosquitoes (a.k.a. "the ankle biters"), which can spread dengue fever, yellow fever, chikungunya, and Zika. Because mosquitoes can fly from one property to another, "Together We Fight!" is OCMVCD's call to action this season that encourages everyone to unite in dumping and draining standing water.

Residents should follow these steps to prevent mosquitoes:

- Eliminate all sources of standing water, including water in flowerpots, old tires, buckets, pet dishes, and trash cans.
- Install screens on doors and windows and keep them in good repair.
- Repair leaky faucets and broken sprinklers that can create standing water.
- Clean rain gutters.
- Report neglected swimming pools.
- Follow label instructions to apply insect repellent containing an EPA-registered active ingredient such as DEET, picaridin, oil of lemon eucalyptus, or IR3535.
- Wear long sleeves and pants, especially when outside at dawn and dusk, when mosquitoes that can spread West Nile virus are most active.

During National Mosquito Awareness Week, OCMVCD will share tips and educational content on mosquitoessuck.org and via social media. Residents can also participate in the Mosquito Buster social media challenge, which offers prizes including tickets to an Angels game, the Discovery Cube, the Santa Ana Zoo, and local cinemas.
