### Thanksgiving Holiday Updates and Message from City Administrator Jennifer Lampman

As we prepare to celebrate Thanksgiving, the City of Placentia would like to share important holiday schedule updates, helpful sustainability tips, and a message of gratitude to our community.

#### Holiday Trash Collection Schedule

Trash collection from Monday, November 24, through Wednesday, November 26, will proceed as scheduled. Due to the Thanksgiving holiday:

- Thursday collection (Nov. 27) will occur on Friday, Nov. 28
- Friday collection (Nov. 28) will occur on Saturday, Nov. 29
- Regular collection will resume on Monday, December 1

#### Street Sweeping Schedule

There will be no street sweeping on Thursday, November 27, or Friday, November 28. If your regular day falls on either date, sweeping will resume on your next scheduled service day. Full service returns on Monday, December 1.

City facilities will be closed on November 26 and November 27 in observance of the holiday. The Police Department and Fire and Life Safety Department will remain open to serve the community. 
