Park Improvement Projects

The Recreation and Parks Commission through many site surveys and park visits identified several City parks that needed accessibility improvements such as replacement of walkway and security lighting along with additional park amenities. Based on the input and surveys of the Commission and feedback received from residents, Community Services staff was able to secure \$230,000 in grant funding and matched it with \$160,000 in local park development funds for park improvement projects. The improvements include installation of new light fixtures and a new pedestrian bridge along with resurfacing athletic courts at Parque De Los Ninos; resurfacing athletic courts and installation of new benches at McFadden Park; installation of new picnic tables and light fixtures along with a drinking fountain at Santa Fe Park; and installation of a new picnic area at La Placita Parkette. In addition twelve new energy efficient park lighting fixtures at Los Vaqueros Park, three new fixtures at Kraemer Memorial Park, and four new fixtures at Goldenrod Park were also installed.

Tri-City Park Property Transfer

The Tri-City Park Authority (that includes members representing each of the cities of Placentia, Brea and Fullerton and responsible for the park's operations since 1974) and the County of Orange, have unanimously approved the transfer of Tri-City Park to the County's Regional Park System effective January 1, 2013.

Residents can expect the continuation of community events like Concerts in the Park on summer evenings and the annual Heritage Festival & Parade held in October. The many park amenities that include fishing, jogging, walking, and family picnic areas, will continue to be available to the community. The County of Orange is committed to maintaining its parks to the highest standards and will be able to complete needed capital improvements at the Park creating a win-win situation for the community.

Earthquake Safety Tips: Water Heater Bracing

Since July 1, 1991, California Health & Safety Code Sections 19210-19217 requires any new or replacement water heater sold be braced, anchored or strapped when installed to resist falling or horizontal displacement due to earthquake forces. This movement can result in gas line or water line leaks and electrical wiring damage. If you have a standing water heater you should examine it to make sure that it is properly braced. Water heater replacement requires a permit from the Building Department, so please always make sure that you obtain (or have your contractor obtain) this low cost permit to ensure your home is safe!

Stormwater Tips for Spring Projects

Whether your spring project is a new coat of paint, a thorough house cleaning, or major remodeling, taking some simple preventative measures will keep the waste materials that might be created from polluting our environment.

Painting: Prevent spills by placing your opened paint cans into secondary containment such as a cat litter box or an old cookie sheet. It is imperative that you do not hose down spilled paint.

Landscaping: Protect stockpiles of materials from wind and rain by covering them with tarps or plastic sheeting. Deliveries of soil, sand or fertilizer must not be unloaded onto the street or gutter.

Concrete: When demolishing existing pavement, remove and recycle all the waste concrete chunks. You can call Placentia Disposal, Inc. at (714) 238-3300 for assistance with obtaining a waste bin that will suit your needs. Do not wash concrete mixers or pumps into the gutter or street.

Solar Energy Systems Simple Permits

Solar energy systems are quickly becoming commonplace in residential neighborhoods. Typical installations include twenty or more solar panels placed on south facing roofs to soak up the sunlight and convert it into energy for your home electrical needs. The City of Placentia helps make residential solar projects feasible through reduced permitting costs and expedited review of solar applications. In 2009 the City reduced its solar permit review fee to \$99 to encourage solar installations. Together with normal electrical and building permits, the overall permitting cost is one of the lowest in the County. It is important to remember that as the property owner, you are required to make sure your installer pulls all necessary permits and seeks City review prior to any work taking place. The City's processing time is only a few days and it ensures that solar panels are arranged in such a way as to fit in with the neighborhood and reduce potential glare issues affecting neighbors. Making sure your solar installer visits the City first for review and permits to ensure that all legal requirements are complied with and that your solar system can start generating savings for you in the quickest time frame. So if you go solar, go to the City first, then start your savings!
