



State of California's Mandatory Recycling Laws: Brief Guide for Multi-Family Residents

State laws require multi-family residents to divert materials from the landfill, in an effort to reduce greenhouse gas emissions.

AB 341 MANDATORY COMMERCIAL RECYCLING

Applies to all multi-family complexes with 5+ units



Diversion of recyclables
(glass, aluminum, plastic,
cardboard, paper)


AB 1826 MANDATORY COMMERCIAL ORGANICS RECYCLING



Diversion of green
(landscaping) waste

SB 1383 SHORT-LIVED CLIMATE POLLUTANTS

Applies to all multi-family complexes



Diversion of organic materials
(derived from plants or animals -
food, food-soiled paper,
landscape/green waste, paper,
lumber, manure)

FUTURE DISPOSAL: THREE BIN SYSTEM

In the future, residents will have to divert green waste, food, and food-soiled paper. More information about organics diversion will be available soon.



Receptacle colors and size options may vary.

Please note: In multi-family complexes, waste services (including the implementation of recycling and organics receptacles) are usually handled by the landlord, association and/or property management team. Please inquire with them about service availability.
